The petitioners had filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that one FIR No.242 dated 19.08.2023 under Sections 363,368,34 of IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar has been registered against petitioner No.1 and he has been arrested in the present case. Learned State counsel further submits that petitioner No.2 has been taken to “After Care Home”, Amritsar.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly dismissed.
