This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.214 dated 04.09.2022 under Section 22 (a) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDSP Act added lateron) registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 08.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI - Sukhwinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
