LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant, challenging judgment and decree dated 21.04.2022, passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurdaspur, whereby petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, filed by the present appellant, who is the grand-father of the minor child, has been dismissed while granting visitation rights, details of which are found in para 22 of the impugned judgment.

2. When this matter came up for hearing on 26.09.2022 before the co-ordinate Bench, it was adjourned to enable learned counsel for the appellant to seek instructions from the appellant as to how future of the minor child would be secured. None appeared on behalf of the appellant thereafter.

3. Today again despite the matter being called twice, none appears on behalf of the appellant. It appears that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

4. Appeal is accordingly dismissed in default/for non prosecution.
