SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

1. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits, that he has instructions to withdraw the instant writ petition, in case a mandamus is made upon the respondents concerned to, within the ambit of the relevant rules and policies, consider the petitioners' prayer for a deed of conveyance, in respect of the disputed land, being executed in their favour, by the authorized officer concerned.

2. The above prayer is accepted, and, a direction is made upon the respondents concerned to, in accordance with law, consider the petitioners' claim for lawful permission being granted for the writ lands being sold to the petitioners.

3. The above be done, on an application being preferred, within two weeks, by the petitioners before the competent authority, and, the latter,

on receiving such an application, but, in accordance with law, and, after hearing all concerned, shall make a lawful decision thereon, yet preferably, within a period of three months of its preferment.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
