At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjeet Singh, has opposed the prayer made by the counsel opposite for extending the concession of bail to the petitioner, by submitting that no doubt the petitioner has been in custody since 13.04.2020, however, the trial is nearing completion as 6 prosecution witnesses out of the 13 cited have been given-up, 4 stand fully examined, the examination-in-chief of 2 witnesses has been done and the remaining prosecution witness, i.e. gazetted officer (DSP), is due to depose on the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court i.e. 11.10.2023.

In the wake of instructions received by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
