This writ petition is filed aggrieved of appellate order restoring the licence of respondent No.4 to run Public Distribution Shop in village Malav, Tehsil Nuh, District Mewat.

The brief facts are that the licence of respondent No.4 was cancelled on a complaint made by the card holders and the petitioner was one of the complainant. The appeal against order dated 3.3.2017 was accepted on 28.3.2017 and the cancellation order was set aside. Aggrieved of the appellate order, the petitioner is before this Court.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 on instructions submits that respondent No.4 has surrendered the depot, hence, no cause of action survives for pursuing the petition. He has produced the photocopy of the letter dated 15.3.2018.

In view of above, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
