Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to conduct a fresh demarcation of NH-344-A for the purposes of four laning of Phagwara-Roopnagar section and construction of an elevated road, in the town of Banga, since the earlier ROW demarcation has been carried out ex parte by the authorities against the principles of natural justice and the said ROW demarcation has illegally enveloped a portion of commercial and residential buildings, owned privately by the petitioners. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to carry out the demarcation of the aforesaid land in the presence of petitioners after affording them an opportunity of hearing and to demolish the buildings

privately owned by the petitioners, which have been enveloped in the project for four-laning of Phagwara-Roopnagar section in the town of Banga on the grounds that the petitioners are illegal encroachers on the same, without carrying out the demarcation in accordance with law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the grievances of the petitioners have been redressed by the respondents authorities, therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
