The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.04, dated 27.2.2008 at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana under Sections 406, 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955 read with Section 13(1), 13(C)(D), 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that the petitioner already stands arrested.

In view of the aforesaid position, the instant petition filed under provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail is rendered infructuous and is disposed off as such.
