DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

In criminal complaint case No.9 of 2014 titled as ‘Rajpal Versus Manoj Kumar and Another’, accused Anil (now petitioner) was declared proclaimed person by learned SDJM, Mahendargarh vide order dated 31.05.2016 (Annexure P-1). However, on account of compromise, complaint itself has already been withdrawn as per order dated 06.05.2019 (Annexure P-4).

2. Prayer in this petition has been made for setting aside the proclamation order (Annexure P-1). Having regard to the fact that complaint itself in which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person has already been dismissed as withdrawn, therefore, impugned order dated 31.05.2016

(Annexure P-1) is hereby set aside having regard to the fact that no consequent FIR under Section 174-A of the IPC was registered against the petitioner as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner.
