Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 05.12.2017 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.1; order dated 22.04.2013 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.3 and order dated 29.07.2010 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.4 vide which the objections against the Naksha B has been wrongly and illegally rejected. Further prayer has been made to uphold the order dated 22.05.2015 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 being well reasoned order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parties have duly compromised the matter by amicable settlement and thus, he does not want to pursue this petition and may be allowed to withdraw the present petition. All the three petitioners who are present in person and have been identified by their counsel have also affirmed this fact.
