ALOK JAIN, J. :

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 22.7.2022 under sections 406, 498-A I.P.C, registered at Police Station Division 3, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 23.09.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation. However, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the complainant submit that the matter has been resolved amicably. A report from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, dated 23.01.2023 has also been received, wherein it has been stated that the dispute has been amicable settled and in

fact the complainant has joined the company of the petitioner.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 23.09.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, with liberty to the parties to proceed in accordance with law and stay bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between them.
