The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 106, dated 10.08.2022, under Section 22 of NDPS Act (Section 29 NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the alleged recovery from the petitioner is of non-commercial in nature and there is non-compliance of Section 50 of the NDPS Act.

Notice of motion.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner today in Court, which is taken on record. According to the custody certificate, the petitioner is behind bars for the last 05 months and 22 days and no other case of similar nature is pending against the petitioner.

Considering the afore-said facts coupled with the facts that the

conclusion of trial shall take sufficient time, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is, therefore, ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Disposed off accordingly.
