1. The instant petition is for issuance of Mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3, to conduct fair and impartial inquiry in the complaint dated 17.11.2018 (Annexure P-1).
2. Today, learned State counsel on instructions informs this Court that the inquiry in the complaint was conducted and it was ordered to be filed which was further accepted by the competent authority concerned.
3. Be that as it may, the petitioner has an efficacious and alternate remedy to raise his grievance, if any, before the appropriate Court/forum. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the ask for relief. The present petition is dismissed, however, with liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate authority/Court/forum for redressal of his grievance, if any.
