1. Disposed of with a direction to the empowered revenue officer concerned to, after proceeding to the relevant site hence with the relevant Masavi, to thereafter in accordance with law, demarcate the relevant site(s), and, to subsequently draw the relevant demarcation report.
2. However, the said demarcation report is permitted to be relied only before the learned executing court concerned. In case, the said demarcation report is placed by the judgment debtor(s) concerned, before the learned executing court concerned, the latter shall, after inviting objections thereto by the aggrieved therefrom, thus thereafter proceed to promptly ensure the completest execution of the verdict(s) of eviction, as became passed against the present petitioners, in respect of the disputed land(s).
3. Disposed of accordingly.
