The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.554 dated 19.11.2022 registered under Sections 379-A & 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, District Rewari.

2. As per the prosecution allegations, on 19.11.2022, a person came to the house of the complainant stating that he had been sent by one Gulshan. Mother of the complainant was taken towards Maars Hospital and in the street, that person after threatening his mother, snatched her gold chain and earrings and fled away. On checking the CCTV footage, the snatcher was identified. FIR was registered.

3. Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner is not visible in CCTV footage and that complainant had refused to identify the applicant in the Test Identification Parade.

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4. Learned State counsel informs that complainant has not been examined till date during trial. Learned State counsel also opposed the bail petition by pointing out that petitioner is involved in as many as 17 other cases as per details given in the custody certificate.

5. Having regard to criminal antecedents of the petitioner and also considering the fact that statement of the victim is yet to be recorded but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Dismissed.
