ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking setting aside of order dated 05.08.2023 passed by the trial Court only to the extent of granting of permission to go abroad (Canada) for a period of 06 months.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of FIR, the petitioner had already visited Canada 07 times to meet his family as he is permanent Canadian resident and returned back well in time. Counsel for the petitioner further undertakes that the petitioner shall return this time also. In case, he does not return, the State may file an appropriate application for cancellation of his passport and shall also ask Canadian Embassy to cancel his PR. He further submits that now petitioner re-schedule his visit from 01.10.2023 to 30.04.2023.

3. Given above, the petitioner is permitted to visit abroad (Canada) from 01.10.2023 to 30.04.2024. It is clarified that in case the petitioner seeks extension of stay in Canada, he is permitted to do the same through his counsel. It is further clarified that the petitioner shall supply all his phone numbers, whatsapp numbers along with his address of residence to the State counsel during the course of the day and shall always keep his numbers active and proper recharge with International roaming.

4. The present petition is allowed to the extent as mentioned above, All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
