1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action on complaint/representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) and register an FIR against respondent No.4 who has duped the petitioner and committed a fraud to the tune of ₹7,50,000/-.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation was given on 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-34 to the police authorities, however, it had failed to yield any response. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaint.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Rahul Mohan, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, District Nuh, is directed to look into his

grievance and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-4), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.
