On the oral request of the counsel for the petitioner, Section 201 IPC is added in the main petition.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.173 dated 30.7.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of earlier order of interim bail passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and no grievous injury is attributed to the petitioner.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and

now the police has prepared the cancellation report in this case and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation in this case.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 27.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
