By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0071 dated 23.10.2020 registered under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 49, Chandigarh.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused issued two fake receipts in respect of the insurance policy to the complainant.

As per the custody certificate, petitioner is already in custody for the last 01 year, 10 months and 07 days. Although he is involved in two more cases but has been acquitted in one case and one case of similar nature is pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mohali.

It is also pointed out that compromise has already been effected amongst the parties, copy of which is placed on record as Annexure P.2.

Though quashing petition based on the compromise was dismissed by the High Court.

Having regard to the period already undergone by the petitioner, trial may take time to conclude, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
