The present petition has been filed raising a grievance that the selection to the post of Conductor/multi tasking transport personnel has been made by the respondents in an arbitrary manner without following any due process and without fixing any criteria.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the candidates, who have competed for appointment to the post of Conductor after being re-commended by the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam, are entitled to know as to what criteria, has been adopted by the respondents for selecting the candidates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 26.07.2023 (Annexure P-14) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in

case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 26.07.2023 (Annexure P-14) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
