1. Nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.
2. The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the order dated 04.08.2021 passed under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and thereafter FIR No.0169 dated 10.08.2021, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 500 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-53, Gurugram.

At the outset, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana and Ms. Promila Nain, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant have stated that the present petition has become infructuous in view of the fact that the State has already filed cancellation report before the learned Magistrate on 09.02.2022.
