This petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 is filed for appointment of an arbitrator for adjudication of the disputes between the parties.

The petitioner was allotted work for special repair of Chandigarh-4-Laned Ropar Bye Pass in District Rupnagar. Clause 25 of the general terms and conditions of contract provides for pre-arbitration mechanism and dispute resolution through arbitration.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises an issue that the petitioner has not availed pre-arbitration mechanism.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail pre-arbitration mechanism.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
