On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

‘Learned counsel appearing for the appellant requests for an adjournment on the ground that the learned counsel, who is to argue the case, has gone abroad.

Learned Senior Counsel assisted by Ms. Parul Aggarwal, Advocate has been waiting to argue the matter on behalf of the respondent since morning when the case was passed over on account of none appearing on behalf of the appellant in the pre-lunch session. No adjournment slip has been attached. Although, no case is made out for grant of adjournment, yet in the interest of justice, adjourned to 26.05.2023 subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/- to be deposited in the High Court Lawyers' Welfare Fund as also by complying with order dated 24.01.2014 within four weeks failing which the interim stay shall stand vacated.’

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the
respondent submits that the order dated 14.03.2023 was clear that no

adjournment is to be granted in the case. He further submits that even today, though an adjournment has been attached but he has not been informed about the same and he raises objection qua the grant of adjournment.

Keeping in view the opinion of the Court expressed in the last order, the same reflects that the appellant is not addressing the arguments on one pretext or the other. Nothing has come on record, as to whether cost of Rs.5000/-, which cost was imposed while granting the adjournment on the last date, has been deposited or not. Further, today also no one appears on behalf of the appellant which clearly shows that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the present appeal.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
