By means of this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-4), passed by the appellate authority, reversing the order dated 08.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Maintenance Tribunal, whereby the claim of petitioner was accepted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the appellate authority while accepting the appeal filed by respondent No.3 held that the claim made by petitioner under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 was not maintainable and this observation is based upon the relation of the parties, who are real brothers. He states that he does not press this petition in order to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law for redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as not pressed.
