As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. Learned counsel for the appellants states that the widow has re-married. The appellants No. 3 and 4 are parents of the deceased. Under above circumstances and as agreed by counsel for the appellants, let the enhanced amount of Rs.50,000/- be paid only to appellant No.2-Harpreet Singh @ Happy Singh, who is the minor son of the deceased.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in the shape of FDR in the name of appellant No.2-Harpreet Singh @ Happy Singh (minor) before the MACT, Patiala on or before 03.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The Tribunal will hand over the FDR to appellant No.2-Harpreet Singh @ Happy Singh, who shall be entitled to encash the same after completing the age of 18 years.

Appeal stands disposed of.
