The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 06.09.2022 registered under Sections 452, 353, 186, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 and 4 of the Punjab Protection of Medicare Service Persons & Medicate Service Institutions (Prevention of Violence & Damage to Property) Bill, 2008 at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Avtar Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 23.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.09.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
