VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Water Supply & Sanitation Office, Sub Division No.1, Division No.2, Partap Chowk Office to Water Supply & Sanitation Office, Kutbewal Gujjaran.

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that since, there is no stay in the present case, thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with his client and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause survives to him.

4. Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to him.
