VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to refund the fee of petitioner no.2 which was deposited by petitioner no.1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioners, the petitioners would give a detailed representation to respondent no.2 and at this stage, would be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to consider the said representation in a time bound manner and if after considering the same, in case, the plea raised by the petitioners is found to be meritorious, then necessary relief be granted to the petitioners.

3. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider the representation of the petitioners and decide the same, in

accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 4 weeks from the date of the receipt of the representation and in case, after considering the same, the plea of the petitioners is found to be meritorious, then necessary relief be granted to the petitioners and in case, the plea of the petitioners is not found to be meritorious, then a speaking order rejecting the same be passed within a period of 4 weeks from the date of the receipt of the representation.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent no.2 would consider and decide the representation independently, in accordance with law.
