1. By this common order, a bunch of writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being decided as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Present petitions have been filed by the petitioners, who were selected against Group-D posts under the Reserved Category of

Outstanding Sportsmen in pursuance to Advertisement No.4/2018 but their services have been terminated by the impugned orders dated 31.08.2019, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-10, Annexure P-11 and Annexure P-12 respectively, on the ground that the Gradation Certificates, which have been produced, were not correct and despite the fact that they were required to produce a Gradation Certificate as per the Government Policy dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-8), the same have not been produced hence, their services were terminated on the ground that petitioners were ineligible to claim appointment in the Reserved Category of Outstanding Sportsmen.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset, submits that petitioners are ready to submit the required sports gradation certificates for the consideration of the authorities concerned and let the respondents consider their claim in case, any such certificate is submitted for consideration of the authorities and their claim be decided by passing a speaking order.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners along with the required document including valid sports gradation certificate so as to prove their eligibility for being appointed against a Group-D post under the Category of the Outstanding Sportsmen, due consideration will be given to the said claim and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, after

the passing of the order, any of the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him/her within a further period of four weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to avail appropriate remedy of representation as prayed for.

6. Ordered accordingly.
