This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.1 to 4 to conclude the partition proceeding vide No.92/NT/P of 21.05.2008 (Annexure P-1) titled as “Satpal VS. Anandpal and others”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for private respondents have jointly submitted that a revision petition filed by respondents No.5 to 7 against the mode of partition is pending before the Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal-respondent

No.2 and have jointly prayed that the Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal be directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible. It is also submitted that on an earlier occasion also direction was issued by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 13.07.2022 passed in CWP-14674-222 to decide the case within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the said order.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the said revision petition is pending for 27.04.2023 and every endeavour would be made by the the Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal to decide the same within a period of one month from 27.04.2023.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal-respondent No.2, before whom the revision petition filed by respondents No.5 to 7 is pending, to decide the said revision petition as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within a period of one month from 27.04.2023.

Counsels appearing before the Commissioner, Karnal Division, District Karnal are also requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.
