Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as not only the allotment has been made but the possession of Plot No.1382, Sector 51 of Urban Estate, Gurugram-II has been handed-over to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner acknowledges the said fact. He, however, states that according to the policy of the respondents, dated 18.02.2013, the petitioner would be entitled to the interest on delayed possession having been granted. It is contended by him that a representation dated 27.01.2023 to this effect has already been submitted by the petitioner.

If that be so, let the said representation be considered and decided by the Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram, within a period of eight weeks from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. The decision

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so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

The present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
