1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 01.05.2023 (Annexure P-15) passed by respondent No.3 wherein the claim of the petitioner for awarding the additional qualification marks as per the criteria of the Advertisement (Annexure P-1) has been declined.

2. A perusal of the impugned order dated 01.05.2023 would show that earlier a writ petition was filed by the petitioner, which was disposed of vide order dated 22.08.2022 and in compliance of the said order, the impugned order has been passed. In the impugned order, at page 64, it has been stated that the B.Com degree of the petitioner has been issued on 31.03.2021, which is subsequent to the cut-off date for submitting the application form i.e., 25.02.2021 and the DMC dated

22.12.2020, which has been annexed with the previous writ petition, was prior to the cut-off date, but the same was not presented at the time of scrutiny. The petitioner is now seeking to place reliance upon a document dated 05.01.2021 and is not in a position to state as to whether the said document was annexed alongwith the representation/writ petition earlier filed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after going through the averments of the previous writ petition/representation and after giving full and better particulars.

4. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
