- The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.
- Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, petitioner was directed to join investigation and was granted interim anticipatory bail, vide order dated 19.09.2023.
- Status report by way of affidavit dated 29.11.2023 has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today, which is taken on record. A copy thereof furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, submits that in pursuance to the aforesaid order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
