Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.7 dated 10.1.2021 registered under Sections 419, 420, 120-B IPC, and Section 66D of Information & Technology (Amendment) Act (Sections 467, 468, 471, 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police multiple times in compliance of previous order passed by this Court.

3. State counsel on instructions from Inspector Dalbir Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated

23.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
