Petitioner Baljit Singh has filed the present civil revision against the impugned order dated 24.05.2023 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, S. B. S. Nagar, vide which, the application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC for impleading as party, was dismissed in default.
