The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0081 dated 20.05.2019, under Sections 365, 120-B IPC, whereas final report/challan has been presented under Sections 306, 342, 201, 120-B IPC (other Sections deleted), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Para 13 of the petition reads as under:-

“13. That the petitioner is law abiding citizen of India and never committed any such offence as alleged in the present FIR. The petitioner is falsely involved in some other cases, in most of which, either he is on bail or already completed the sentences or quashed the FIR.”

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Aaswant Singh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Faridkot, District Faridkot on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab along with custody certificate of petitioner Ranbir Singh. A perusal thereof would show that the petitioner is involved in as many as 9 cases. The details of the same have not been provided in the petition by the counsel for the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
