Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement all the decision of the Competent Authorities including order passed by the SDM-cum-Collector, Agrarian, Ajnala dated 06.05.1977 (Annexure P-1); order passed by the Financial Commissioner dated 27.12.1984 (Annexure P-3) and to deliver the possession of the allotted surplus land to the petitioner being legal heir of deceased Udam Singh son of Tehal Singh, to whom the surplus land was allotted as per their entitlement. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-8) issued by the petitioner to the respondents by way of passing a speaking order within a time bound manner and if the claim of the petitioner was found to be legal, then further direction be issued to take effective steps to hand over the physical possession of the land to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already served legal notice dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondents, however, till date no action has been taken on the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for both the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that one Amrik Singh having similar case had approached this Court by way of filing **CWP No.18357 of 2023** with the similar prayer and this Court disposed of the same vide order dated 22.08.2023 directing the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Agrarian to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law.

The present case is covered by the decision of the abovesaid **CWP No.18357 of 2023**. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Agrarian, Amritsar to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
