Main case

While praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, the petitioner, in substance, prays for direction to the respondents to appoint him as Warder.

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In the written statement, it has been disclosed that the petitioner applied under the Backward Class category. In the written and physical efficiency test, the cut off marks for the candidates of the Backward Class category were 25 marks whereas the petitioner was able to secure only 23 marks, hence, he was not called for interview.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner failed to controvert the aforesaid facts.

Hence, dismissed.
