Prayer in the present petition is for quashing/setting aside the order dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Collector, Jalandhar as well as the order dated 16.01.2018 (Annexure P-9) passed by learned Commissioner, Jalandhar under The Public Premises and Land Recovery (Eviction of Rent Recovery) Act, 1973 whereby the petitioner has been illegally ordered to be evicted in contravention to the settled principles of law as well as in contravention to the order dated 18.02.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CR No.8628-2015.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted before this Court that after filing of this petition, the premises from which the petitioner was evicted had already been handed over to the respondent and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
