**DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)**

Prayer in this petition is to quash order dated 09.05.2023 (Annexure P-3), whereby bail earlier granted to the petitioners was cancelled by learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana during the proceedings of case FIR No.136, dated 23.05.2023, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners were allowed bail on 21.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise effected between the parties. However, petitioners could not appear on 19.04.2023 before the Court, due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were issued against them. Learned counsel further contends that petitioners are ready to surrender before the Trial Court.

Let the petitioners surrender before the Trial Court on or before 05.09.2023, the date already fixed thereat. On their such surrender, the Trial Court shall initiate the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C.

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and after disposal of those proceedings, the petitioners shall be admitted to bail. Till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioners shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioners are sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having been issued against them, they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
