1. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in the case bearing FIR No. 24 dated 05.04.2021 under Sections 363/366/376(2)N/376(3) IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act registered at Police Station IT Park, U.T.Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent-U.T.Chandigarh, on instructions from SI Dilawar Singh, submits that the trial of the case has culminated in acquittal of the petitioner in terms of the judgment dated 03.08.2023 passed by the learned Judge, Fast Track, Special Court (Chandigarh) and consequently, the present petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the categorical assertion made by learned counsel for the respondent-U.T.Chandigarh, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, he shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned counsel for the respondent-U.T. Chandigarh is found to be factually incorrect.
