The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 103 dated 06.08.2022 registered under Sections 120-B and 420 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel filed status report by way of affidavit of Manoj Gors, PPS, Deputy Supdt. of Police, Sub-Division Moonak on behalf of respondent No.1-State and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Lal, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting

on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.09.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
