On 29.08.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“ The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a perusal of the original proclamation order dated 21.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) would show that the same was served upon the accused on 11.12.2022 with a direction that he should appear on 06.01.2023 and therefore, 30 days period had not been given for the appearance of the accused as mandated under the law. Even otherwise, the petitioner had vacated the house on which the proclamation had been posted in 2021. He states that he is ready and willing to join proceedings.

Notice of motion for 07.11.2023.

In the meantime, the operation of the order dated 21.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) shall remain stayed.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of 2 weeks from today and on his doing

so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”.

On 07.11.2023, the following order was passed:-

“As per office report, notice issued to the respondent received back unserved with the report that the Branch Manager said that the office has been shifted to Sector-101, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.08.2023, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and he has to be released on interim bail.

In the meantime, fresh notice to the respondent/complainant at the fresh address, submitted by the petitioner, be issued for 05.12.2023.

Dasti as well”.

In view of the aforementioned orders, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Duty and has since been admitted to bail as is borne out from the order dated 12.09.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.
