The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.117 dated 05.06.2022 as registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur, under Section 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from HC Jasvir Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 10.11.2022, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation

is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to petitioner-Kamal Gupta by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 10.11.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
