1. This petition is filed quashing of FIR No. 29 dated 26.3.2018 unde Sections 279/337/427 IPC, 1860 registered at P.S. SAS Nagar.

2. During the pendency of the petition, the petitioner No.2 filed an application alleging that her signatures have been forged on the compromise as well as on the Power of Attorney filed here in this Court.

3. On 1.5.2023, the following order was passed :-

“CRM-19566-2023

This application has been filed for placing on record Annexures exemption from filing certified copies thereof. AX/1 to AX/15 and for For the reasons stated therein, application is allowed and Annexures aforementioned are taken on record. Exemption sought for is granted.

CRM-6818-2023

Application is allowed as prayed for.

CRM-6819-2023

This application has been filed for taking appropriate action against petitioner No. 1 as she has allegedly forged the signatures of petitioner No. 2 on the vakalatnama and compromise deed dated 12.09.2022.

Learned State counsel is directed to obtain the admitted signatures of the applicant by way of bank opening form or some other similar document which was executed much before 12.09.2022.

Adjourned to 02.08.2023.

4. On 2.8.2023, the petitioners were unrepresented. On 11.8.2023, on request made on behalf of learned counsel for petitioner No.1, the matter was adjourned.
5. Today none appeared on behalf of petitioner No. 1.
6. The compromise itself is in doubt, consequently, no further directions are called for. Petition is dismissed.
7. Needless to say that petitioner No.2 would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, regarding the filing of forged documents in this Court.
8. Since the main case has been dismissed the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
