Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.154 dated 4.6.2021 registered under Sections 201, 302, 34 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act added later on at Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar.

On the last date of hearing, interim bail was granted to the petitioner and he was directed to join the investigation with the police on the ground that material witnesses namely Sanjay, Pawan, Jaipal and Ram Pal retracted from their previous statements in the trial being faced by co-accused Mohit, Surinder, Arun and Sushil. On the last date of hearing, counsel for the complainant was present and he admitted the fact that the material witnesses resiled from their previous statements during the trial

faced by co-accused Mohit, Surinder, Arun and Sushil.

Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that the petitioner joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order.

State counsel on instructions from DSP Naresh Kumar submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further submits that he got effected recovery of one wooden stick and Creta car and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 27.10.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
