The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 29.12.2017, passed by this Court in CRM-41638-2017 in CRM-M-41790-2017, vide which, in a petition filed by the petitioner for transfer of investigation in FIR No. 16 dated 08.02.2017, registered under Sections 279, 304-A of the IPC at Police Station Barara, District Ambala, a direction was issued to respondent No. 16 not to remove the vehicle from the above said place till the next date of hearing.

In the aforesaid case, one of the contentions of the petitioner was that respondent No. 16 i.e. Insurance Company is likely to sell the salvage of the vehicle and the relevant clues will be lost, however, it is admitted case that subsequently on 21.11.2019, the main case itself was dismissed as withdrawn.
