This is an application to place on record the orders dated 22.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) and the order dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-4), whereby petitioner had been allowed bail in two other cases.

Allowed.

Annexures P-3 and P-4 are taken on record.

Main Case

Prayer is made for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.105, dated 26.04.2022, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla, under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Latest custody certificate of the petitioner has been placed on record by learned State counsel, revealing that petitioner is in custody for the last 9 months and 13 days in this case.

Allegations are that 1000 intoxicant tablets were recovered from the possession of co-accused Shehbaz. It is alleged that petitioner is the supplier of the contraband tablets to co-accused Shehbaz.

Admittedly, no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. He is in custody for the last 9 months and 13 days in this case.

Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting further on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
