Learned counsle for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already joined in terms of the impugned transfer order dated 12.04.2023. Further he submits that the order is illegal as it goes against the Instructions dated 10.04.2023 issued by the respondents.

I have considered the submissions and perused the Instructions dated 10.04.2023. From the perusal of the said Instructions, it is apparent that transfer order can be passed in special administrative circumstance. The impugned transfer order mentions of transferring the petitioner on administrative issue.

In view thereof, the transfer cannot be said to be in contravention of the Guidelines dated 10.04.2023 issued by the State Govt.

Writ petition is misconceieved.
