DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the remaining amount of service-cum-retirement dues of the petitioners including travel concession, as well as medical allowance and arrears of travel concession and medical allowance of the petitioners and all other benefits along with interest for delayed period.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.4 on instructions from Jeevan Bansal, Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Abohar submits that after due calculation, the amount claimed by the petitioners shall be released/disbursed to the petitioners within a period of 8 weeks.

In view of the above, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the respondent No.4 is directed to release the due amount to the petitioners within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

The present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
